

Recommendations. PLEASE:

- Respect protected zones (cf. 'Legislation' box opposite)
- Stay on marked paths
- Take photos rather than pick (or walk over) the plants.
- Leave no trace: take your rubbish home.
- Close gates and barriers behind you.
- Always observe wildlife from a distance.
- Remember that enjoying the unspoiled nature of the Park is a privilege, not a gift.
- Use public transport where possible.

Certain areas of the Gruyère Pays-d'Enhaut Regional Nature Park are more vulnerable than others. Special rules therefore apply, particularly to hikers. Please comply with the relevant rules and regulations and adapt your behaviour accordingly.

Legislation

In some nature reserves, it is against the law to leave the marked hiking trails. Protected zones and the relevant legal restrictions are shown on the map overleaf.
