

Recommendations. PLEASE:

- Comply with the specific rules on protected areas and forests (cf. 'Legislation' box opposite)
- Keep your dog under control at all times and do not allow it to foul the meadows.
- Avoid grazing land where a guard dog is present.
- Close gates and barriers behind you.
- Leave no trace. Take your rubbish home.
- Do not approach or disturb the wildlife.
- Do not walk over the grasslands. Stay on the paths.

Responsible visitor behaviour



Visiting with dogs










Certain areas of the Gruyère Pays-d'Enhaut Regional Nature Park are more sensitive than others. Special rules therefore apply, particularly on bringing dogs into the Park. Please comply with the relevant rules and regulations and adapt your behaviour accordingly. By acting responsibly, you are helping to preserve the mountain landscape and ensure a positive Park experience for yourself and other users.

Legislation

From 1 April to 15 July, dogs must be kept on a leash when in the Park's forests (FR and VD). In the canton of Vaud, they must always be kept on a leash when walking along the forest's edge and in the meadows around the forests.

Dogs must always be kept on a leash when in wildlife protection zones (federal game reserves and canton of Vaud wildlife reserves). Dogs are not permitted in certain nature reserves such as Vanil Noir and La Pierreuse). See map overleaf for more details.

Restricted areas - Visiting with dogs

-  Park perimeter
-  Dogs are not permitted in this area
-  Dogs must be kept on a leash
-  Dogs must be kept on a leash - 01/12 to 30/06
-  Dogs must be kept on a leash - 01/01 to 30/06
-  Dogs must be kept on a leash, in event of snow
-  Use of dog leash recommended – in event of snow
-  Off limits – in event of snow
-  Sensitive area – do not enter in event of snow
